- * The Nicole Jarvis, MD Parkinson's Research Foundation is a 501c3 non profit organization founded in 2012 by Dr. Nicole Jarvis, after being diagnosed with Young Onset Parkinson's Disease at age 38 years old.
- * Our mission is to raise awareness of Parkinson's Disease at a local, national, & global level; to raise funds for cutting edge PD research; and to raise funds to support services for local patients & their families battling PD.
- * 90% of what we raise we donate to Team Fox in support of The Michael J. Fox Foundation, of which LITERALLY 100% is used to fund research for improved treatments and ultimately a cure!
- * 10% of the funds we raise are donated to the Parkinson Foundation of Oklahoma to help fund services for local PD patients & families, such as education classes, voice therapy, boxing, & support groups.
- * We have NO paid employees or overhead expenses! NONE of the money we raise is used to pay expenses. LITERALLY 100% of all funds we raise is used to fund research and local patient services.
- * We have donated over \$1.3 Million to Team Fox! We are one of the top 10 fundraisers (out of 4,000) every year!
- * We have donated over \$100,000 to Parkinson Foundation of Oklahoma to fund local services!

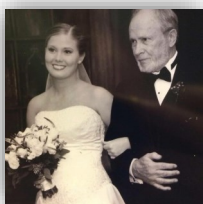
